NFL LINCOLN-DOUGLAS DEBATE TOPIC BALLOT

Please check the five topics which your NFL chapter would most like to debate. The results of this balloting will determine the 2006 Lincoln-Douglas topics for: January- February (3rd choice), March - April (2nd choice), Nationals (1st Choice), September - October (5th choice), and November - December (4th choice).

- 1. A victim's deliberate use of deadly force is a just response to repeated domestic violence.
- 2. The use of the state's power of eminent domain to promote private enterprise is unjust.
- 3. The US should accept the jurisdiction of the International Criminal Court.
- 4. In matters of family planning, the autonomy of the adolescent should outweigh the competing interests of the parent/guardian.
- 5. Mandatory term limits for elected officials are antithetical to representative democracy.
- 6. Gender categorization ought to be deemphasized in schools.
- 7. School administrators are justified in exercising editorial control over secondary school publications for reasons other than legal liability.
- 8. A just government should provide health care to its citizens.
- 9. Juveniles charged with violent crimes should be tried and punished as adults.
- 10. In matters of collecting military intelligence, the ends justify the means.
